MMM 9 will take place in the Center for Advanced Academic Studies in Dubrovnik, Croatia, Sept 15-18, 2013.

The theme of the conference is 'Morphology and Semantics'. The relationship between form and meaning is a central topic of morphological research. It is of central relevance for our view of the architecture of grammar, the nature of morphological generalizations, and the structure of the lexicon. More specific issues are the systematicity in the interpretation of compounds, the polysemy and/or homonymy of affixes, the role of paradigmatic relations in the semantic interpretation of complex words, bracketing paradoxes, and semantic compositionality at the level of the word.

In addition, there will be a special section devoted to the morphology of Croatian. It is also possible to submit an abstract on other morphological topics, for which a number of slots will be reserved in the program.

The opening session of the conference will take place in the evening of Sept. 15, followed by two full day sessions (Sept 16-17). A social program will be offered for Sept. 18.

The abstract should be sent in two versions, one anonymous, and one with the following information: surname, given name, affiliation, institutional address, e-mail address.

Selection of abstracts will be done by the scientific committee, on the basis of the anonymous versions of the abstracts.

We expect that there will be room for 25 talks, including three by invited speakers, and for 20 posters. A substantial time slot will be reserved for posters. The time for each talk is 25 minutes + 10 minutes for discussion; for the invited speakers there will be 35+10 minutes available.

Registration costs will be 60 €. Accommodation will be available through CAAS.
